Online storage and sharing services

They enable users to store, manage and access their files and data on remote servers. This data can then be accessed from any device connected to the Internet. The most popular are Google Drive, Dropbox, Microsoft One Drive and Amazon S3.

The main features

- Upload files, documents, photos and videos to the **online storage service**.
- Automatic **synchronisation** across multiple devices, accessible from any Internet-connected device.
- **Share files** or folders with other users by sending them access links and setting permissions.
- Some online storage services include **collaboration tools** that allow several users to work together on documents in real time.
